

The three chambers combine to make this class a successful opportunity, and provide people with a greater understanding of county operations and services along with professional growth experiences to serve their members.

Supporting the retail community is provided for through annual campaigns and special shopping events, group advertising programs, and the sale of chamber gift certificates.

We offer chamber memberships to businesses, community service groups, and individuals who want to play an important role in our community development.

NEW BREMEN LOCKKEEPERS HOUSE

The original lockkeeper's house was burned down as a fire exercise in 1968. Today, it has been reconstructed in its original location to once again be a focal point in the Golden Triangle of Auglaize County. It is the current office of the Southwestern Auglaize County Chamber of Commerce and The New Bremen Foundation. It welcomes travelers and visitors, as they pass through our community or take a stroll along the Miami-Erie Canal. The cost of the building was \$630,000, funded by an Ohio Department of Transportation enhancement grant of \$500,000 and the remaining \$130,000 provided by the New Bremen Historic Association.

The Lockkeepers Hose was the residence of the lockkeeper and his family. He was on duty 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and was responsible for operating the lock as needed to keep boats moving along through the canal. The lock tender manually opened and closed the large wooden gates by pushing on the huge handles of the 7,000-pound gates.


Great care was taken in the restoration of the current building to maintain the integrity of the original structure. The concrete was poured using forms specifically designed to replicate a look of wooden planks to give the appearance of the original construction. The anchoring irons on the south side are original pieces. All other metal work was fabricated using traditional techniques that would have been used in the original construction.

During demolition of the deteriorated lock, the original footers were found to be in such excellent condition that they were able to be reused in this project. This is the third lock on the Miami Erie Canal to use original footers in its reconstruction.

Lock One North is 15 feet wide, 90 feet long and 20 feet deep. The gates are constructed of white oak which was readily available at the time and which provides strength and resistance to deterioration by water. Each gate weighs 7,000 pounds and are 22 feet in length. Concrete lock currently near Lock One was salvaged from the original and shoes "rope burns" from where the ropes that were used to tow the boat would scrape along the lock.

New Bremen prospered because of the canal which supplied jobs during construction and provided businesses and farmers a means of transporting their products to market economically. Mills and lumber companies in New Bremen were powered by canal water and ice companies obtained their ice from the ponds and white water associated with the canal when the canal was frozen over and could not be used for transport. New Bremen had five hotels and ten saloons which were built to accommodate canal boat passengers. At the height of its use in 1850, an estimated 400 boats regularly traveled the canal between Toledo and Cincinnati.





A TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE

For more than a century and a half southwestern Auglaize County has been an excellent place to call home. During the 1830s the first German immigrants began to build their towns at Minster (1832), New Bremen (1833) and New Knoxville (1836).

Within a generation they turned a wilderness into successful farming communities. In 1848 the completion of the Miami-Erie Canal between Cincinnati and Toledo

brought prosperity to the region. Surplus grain and hogs were shipped out on the canal and manufactured goods came in to the communities.

By the end of the 19th century a number of local industries were thriving in the area. There were flour mills, breweries, tanneries, tile kilns and pork packers. Local plants were making barrels, furniture, farm plows and machine presses. Today these industrial roots have grown into dozens of companies with reputations for quality known around the world.

Since the arrival of those first German immigrants in the 1830s, Minster, New Bremen and New Knoxville have grown and prospered. The legacy of those German pioneers—strong faith, hard work and a dedication to excellence—continues today, making these communities truly The Golden Triangle of Auglaize County.



AGRICULTURE IN AUGLAIZE COUNTY

Drive through beautiful rural Auglaize County and you will observe the vast expanse of agriculture in the county. Agriculture is the number one industry in Auglaize County.

Soils in the county are highly productive. The total land mass of Auglaize County is 257,000 acres. Eighty-two percent (210,018 acres) of the total land mass is used to grow agricultural commodities. Auglaize County ranks 25th in the state for land used for agricultural purposes. There are 976 farms in Auglaize County accounting for 1.4% of all Ohio farms. The average farm size in the county is 215 acres, 36 acres greater than the state average. Total cash receipts for crops and livestock in Auglaize County exceeded \$206,000,000 in 2017. Thirty-six percent of Auglaize County farms have cash receipts of \$50,000 to \$499,999. Another 10 percent of farms have cash receipts of \$500,000 or greater.

Agriculture in Auglaize County is more than just farming. The agribusiness industry encompasses food and feed processing and storage and distribution of farm commodities. Minster, Ohio is home to Dannon, the largest yogurt processing plant east of the Mississippi River. Dannon has greater than 400 employees and makes greater than 6 million cups of yogurt a day. St. Marys, Ohio is home to Pro-Pet, manufacturer of premium and super-premium pet foods. G.A Wintzer

& Sons Co. located near Wapakoneta, Ohio recycles proteins and fats into products used in pet and livestock feeds and biofuels. In addition, farmers rely heavily upon numerous local agribusinesses to manage their operations. These agribusinesses provide equipment, tools, feed, nutrients, pesticides, seed, materials, fuel, animal care, consulting, financing, insurance, and numerous other products and services to farmers and other residents.





The Village of Minster exceeds expectations when it comes to workforce. The labor force of Auglaize and neighboring Shelby and Mercer counties, based on place of residence, exceeds 60,000 people; within a 30 mile radius this number increases to approximately 149,000. The unemployment rate in Auglaize County is currently lower than the rate in the State of Ohio.

THE VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN

Life along the Miami-Erie Canal has given New Bremen a rich and colorful history. In the early days, canal boats made the west central community a regular stop for trade and commerce. EXPLORE THE GREAT OUTDOORS IN NEW BREMEN

New Bremen is nestled in the heart of scenic Ohio farmland, with plenty of open spaces where outdoor enthusiasts can enjoy fresh air and sunshine.

Do you love the outdoors? Spend your afternoon enjoying the sights and sounds along the Miami-Erie Trail or the Kuenning Dicke Natural Area. Challenge yourself at the pool, tennis/pickleball courts, disc golf, basketball courts or on the canal path. The canal path is ideal for walking, running or biking.

The perfect park awaits you and your family in New Bremen!

MIAMI AND ERIE TRAIL

The Miami and Erie Trail, a linear park, extends from Lock One south along the canal to the south corporation limits. The trail is built upon the towpath of the historic canal and runs the entire way through the village. The trail, which is part of the Heritage Trail System, continues for 2 miles towards the Village of Minster.



KUENNING-DICKE NATURAL AREA

Located along the historic Miami and Erie Canal between Lock One and the former site of Lock Two, Kuenning Dicke Natural Area offers 71 acres of wildlife protection and a peaceful site for outdoor recreation.

KDNA hosts 2.5 miles of trails for walking, running, hiking and biking.

A 3-acre lake provides ample opportunity for catchand-release fishing, while the primitive campsite is the perfect resting spot for backpackers and cyclists. The park is also home to several small memorials that honor American veterans of wars and conflicts.

BREMENFEST PARK

The park features baseball diamonds, tennis courts, basketball courts, pickleball court, disc golf, shelter houses, restrooms, swimming pool, traditional playground area and a fully accessible playground, as well as White Mountain sledding hill for wintertime fun.

Located adjacent to the standard playground equipment is Sunshine Playground, a fully accessible playground featuring a rubber surface, ramps, wide walkways and special swings. Sunshine Playground is the only 100% ADA-certified playground located in Auglaize County.

This inclusive environment allows for a family to meet the needs of their entire family. Children can play at their physical capability levels while remaining together.

KOMMINSK LEGACY PARK

One of the newest additions to the New Bremen parks scene is Komminsk Legacy Park. It's an interactive art park that draws visitors from all over the region to interact, explore and participate in a way that traditional parks do not allow.

One of the most popular features is the splash pad, which is open to the public from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. during the months of May-September (the exact day of opening and closing is weather dependent). Komminsk Legacy Park features an embankment slide, splash pad, sunshade structure by Tork Werks, amphitheater seating and a commissioned lion sculpture.

SHOPPING & RESTAURANTS

Whether you visit our downtown or The Amsterdam Center, you will find a variety or retail and service businesses which supply basic needs and specialty goods and services as well. And when you don't want to cook, there are several opportunities for dining out—from the casual to more sophisticated.



THE VILLAGE OF NEW KNOXVILLE

Nestled in southern Auglaize County, New Knoxville is located at the intersection of State Routes 29 & 219, and is just minutes from Interstate 75. These highways allow one to travel to/from Chicago, Illinois; Frankfort, Kentucky; Charleston, West Virginia; or Erie, Pennsylvania in less than 5 hours. Whether traveling by car or air, our community is easily accessible. Dayton International Airport is within an hour drive, while Port Columbus International Airport, Toledo Express Airport, and Ft. Wayne International Airport can all be reached in less than 2 hours.

NEIL ARMSTRONG AIRPORT

Just outside the village is The Auglaize County Neil Armstrong Airport which is an important part of our community. It is located adjacent to the Village of New Knoxville's industrial park, and can accommodate all general aviation aircraft, and provide a link for travelers and goods coming into our community from around the world. The airport's 5,650' runway is suitable for all kinds of aircraft including corporate jets. The airport is named after Neil Armstrong, the first man on the moon, who grew up in nearby Wapakoneta, Ohio.

New Knoxville Schools are rated "excellent" by the Ohio Department of Education, with attendance and graduation rates above 98%. The community's commitment to the school is reflected in its renovations and upkeep.
